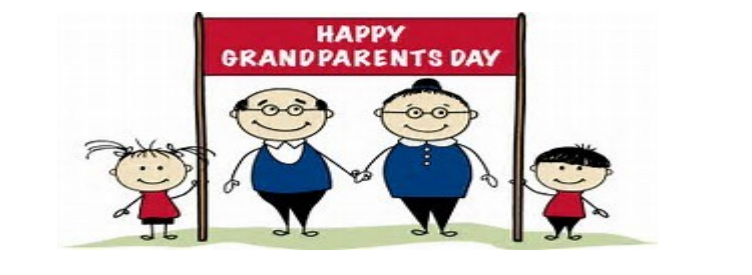

PASTOR'S COMMENT**

\* We welcome those who are in town for Mountain Craft Day or the Flight 93 Commemoration or the Farmers & Threshermens Jubilee. May your stay be pleasant and your journey home safe.

\* Religious Education classes begin today for this academic year. The classes are essential in providing our students with a basic understanding of Catholic doctrine and our way of life. Parents are urged to insure consistent attendance of their children. CCD participation should be an expectation and not a topic of negotiation.

\* Our parish has students at Bishop McCort High School and Divine Mercy Catholic Academy. The parish helps these students with tuition support and transportation subsidy. Our parish is strongly committed to Catholic junior high and high school education for families who desire it.

\* Selling SCRIP is an important, ongoing school fundraiser. It's a great deal: you receive the full retail value for your money and the school benefits. SCRIP order forms are available in the vestibule, the school or rectory. SCRIP for the most popular retailers is usually available at 4:00PM, 8AM and 10AM weekend Masses.

\* On occasion I'm asked about the need for and benefits of Confirmation. The sacrament, along with Baptism and Eucharist, completes the Sacraments of Initiation and brings full membership in the church. The invocation of the Holy Spirit and the sacramental graces received fortify the recipient in resisting temptation and in truly living a Catholic Christian life. Also, one must be a fully initiated member of the church to function as a Lector or Eucharistic Minister at Mass or to serve as a Baptism godparent or Confirmation sponsor. The Sacrament of Confirmation offers profound spiritual and practical benefits.
